### **Advocates for Youth**

#### **Equitable Access to Comprehensive Sex Education**

Support development of Spanish materials of the 3 R's comprehensive sexual health education curriculum, including dissemination of the materials and provision of technical assistance to educators and districts about how to access and effectively use the curriculum.

### **Equitable Access to Comprehensive Sex Education**

Enhance and build up capacity for programming from the Responsible Sex Education Institute (the Institute), including virtual classroom education for middle and high schoolers; comprehensive sex education for people with cognitive disabilities; helpful textlines for parents, educators, and youth; culturally-sensitive programming for Native American communities; and virtual training for youth-serving adults.

### **Anti-Oppressive Practices in Youth Sexual Health Programming**

Implement and expand the Colorado WISE Initiative over two years by working with stakeholders, partners, and equity consultants to incorporate anti-oppressive practices into the WISE Initiative and all aspects of youth sexual health work. Disseminate the next edition of the State of Adolescent Sexual Health Report. The next edition of the report will include a stronger, more robust anti-oppressive framework and recommendations that elevate the next evolution of sex education.
